

RURAL AND EQUITY ENTRY FORM

(MBBS)PART 1: NOTES FOR APPLICANTS

As a Rural/Equity Entry applicant, Curtin Medical School requires you to submit documentation both declaring and confirming your eligibility to apply.

If you believe you qualify for one or both of these entry pathways, please complete this form, **sign the declaration** and forward by email to the Admissions Coordinator by the closing date noted below. If your form is not received by this date or is incomplete, your application for rural/equity entry may not be accepted.

Applicants who qualify for both rural and equity entry can apply for both but will need to indicate their preference on the form.

- **Rural applicants** are those Western Australian applicants who are applying as a Western Australian school leaver, Western Australian Curtin Course Switcher or have completed a tertiary qualification from a Western Australian institution, who as of 31 December prior to commencement of the program, have lived in a rural area at least 10 years cumulatively or any five years consecutively from the commencement of primary school. This time frame is based on the location of your primary residence and cannot be your family's holiday home etc.

Curtin Medical School classifies regions as being rural using the Modified Monash Model – remoteness category (MMM) 3-7. Please note this classification system is used rather than the ASGC-RA classification system. - **Equity applicants** are those Western Australian school leavers who, as of 31 December prior to commencement of the program;
 - have undertaken their entire year 12 studies, including WACE, at a high school with an average Index of Community and Socio-Educational Advantage (ICSEA) of 1,000 and below averaged over three years. To check eligible schools you can search using the website below: <http://www.myschool.edu.au/>
 - are classified as experiencing financial hardship (a student receiving Youth Allowance, or their parent or guardian receiving a Commonwealth Income Support, or Commonwealth Means-tested Assistance Payment).

Rural Entry Confirmation - Notes for Applicants and Community Members

Curtin Medical School requires you to submit documentation confirming your eligibility to apply as a Western Australian school leaver rural applicant. This is through a compulsory declaration to be completed by a recognised member of your community, confirming that you have met the following criteria:

- residing in a primary residence in a MMM remoteness category area 3-7,
- for five consecutive or 10 cumulative years,
- since the commencement of primary school prior to the commencement of the program.
- a current WA Year 12 School Leaver, WA Curtin course switcher or have completed a tertiary qualification from a Western Australian institution.
